Phil Nies was elected chairman and Kelly Nechuta was elected recorder.

The purpose of the committee was neither to add nor subtract from the current ordinance except to comply with NR115, clarify or put in place current departmental policies as have been approved by the Zoning Committee but not included in the current ordinance.

The committee agreed to use the work product of the previous Zoning Administrator as the template for the proposed ordinance. The committee also decided to create a stand alone ordinance rather than to amend the current ordinance. Each section was reviewed and issues, errors and omissions were resolved into the current attached document. We had received suggestions and comments from a number of other parties and the DNR.

On February 4, 2011, the committee met and adopted the document we are presenting to you and would urge the Zoning and Conservation Committee to review, and if found to have merit, forward to the DNR for review before the time and expense of public hearings are incurred.
